The County of Dorset (A353, A353 (Grove Hill), A353 (Main Road), C42 (Mills Road) & D21401 (Upton), Osmington, Owermoigne & Poxwell) (30mph, 40mph and 50mph Speed Limits) (No. 19) Order 2025

Dorset Council has made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended.

When the Order comes into operation on 28th March 2025 the effect of the Order will be to revoke part of the 40mph speed limit on the A353 (Main Road) and introduce a 30mph speed limit on parts of the A353 (Grove Hill) and A353 (Main Road), the C42 (Mills Road) and the D21401 (Upton), a 40mph speed limit on parts of the A353 and A353 (Grove Hill) and a 50mph speed limit on part of the A353 (Grove Hill).
